

A note from Pastor Dave

This morning I again read the story of Jesus, found in Mark's gospel, chapter two. If you're looking for a nice, quiet God who won't disrupt your life, well, look again at Jesus! When He comes He'll stir up your business, your marriage, and your finances. He's a functioning, moving, teaching, touching, powerful God, who won't sit in a corner like an ornament!

In Scripture people opened their homes for Jesus to come and preach. Maybe they thought, "We'll put out a few extra chairs...it'll be nice to hear a good sermon...we could use some prayer." Wow! Were they ever surprised! When word got out, the people came from everywhere! It got so crazy that when four men carrying a sick friend on a stretcher couldn't get in, they cut a hole in the roof and lowered him down to Jesus. Maybe that's what we need today - people who know how to "raise the roof" with their prayers, their praises, and bring down the power of God.

Get ready: when you let Jesus into ANY area of your life, He'll ask you to give what you can't give, do what you can't do, and be what you can't be. He'll rearrange everything! And, empowered by His presence, He will stretch us to do more than we've ever done before. Are we ready to say, "yes?"

March and April are "stretching" months (maybe every month fits that category!).

- We begin on the 7th with our Faith Promise Sunday. Dr. Paul Maxfield will be sharing in our services that day. Please pray for this service, and seek His direction as to how you can participate. Are we ready to say, "yes?"
- This year we are again targeting our community, inviting our neighbors to be here for Easter services. For both Palm Sunday (March 28) and Easter Sunday (April 4), we will have three worship services (offered at 8:00, 9:30, and 11:00). What if we have 600 people in worship? I believe God would be honored, lives would be changed, and we would be blessed! Someone is waiting - to be invited. Are we ready to say, "yes?"
- Sunday evening, April 11 we will be honored to host the Africa Children's Choir! This is an experience of worship you will not want to miss! I anticipate a packed church as these children share from their hearts about how God has changed their lives! You will have an opportunity to open your home and host members of this group, adding to the richness of blessing! Are we ready to say, "yes?"
- The Men's Ministry, so strong and vibrant over the years, is looking to grow deeper in the things of God. It is an honor to be with such Godly men, who desire to grow more like Christ. Men, are we ready to say, "yes?"
- Imagine the unspeakable joy when a homebound person receives a visit! You can be a part of a new visitation ministry and for a few moments of your time, you can be a blessing - and you will in turn be blessed. Are we ready to say, "yes?"

This church is filled with wonderful people! It is honestly a privilege to serve by your side - and a joy to say "yes" to Him as He leads us into an exciting future together. Remember you are loved!
